Artificial Insemination with Partner's or Donor's Sperm

Cumulative Clinical Pregnancy Rate after Three Attempts of Artificial Insemination (%):

| Type | Pregnancy Rate |

| IAH (Partner's Sperm) | 59.15% |
| IAD (Donor's Sperm) | 51.07% |

Percentage of Cases According to Specific Factors

| Factor | Percentage |
|--|------------|
| Male factor infertility (non-normozoospermia per WHO parameters) | 74.35% |
| Poor ovarian response (fewer than 6 mature oocytes retrieved) | 58.31% |
| Age \geq 40 years at the time of assisted reproductive treatment | 58.75% |

Notes

The results in this report are expressed as Cumulative Clinical Pregnancy Rate (or ongoing pregnancy rate), meaning pregnancies verified via ultrasound, as opposed to the chemical pregnancy rate or general pregnancy rate, which count all cases with a positive pregnancy test regardless of subsequent ultrasound confirmation.

In no case was the transfer of more than two embryos performed.
